Meeting Minutes

1. Principals report

- a) Camp Cedardwood coming up. This is held every winter for Grade 8 students. There is a cost involved but no student will be left behind due to finances. Approximately 85-90% of students attend.
- b) Activity letters being sent home soon. School will cover the costs for the local events.
- c) Knights of the month: Posters are distributed all over the school defining what it is to be a knight. Teachers from each grade level choose the knights of the month.
