SMS CODE of CONDUCT



BEHAVIOUR	STUDENT
Attendance	Attend school regularly. If you leave during the day, have a note signed by parent or notify parents for permission.
Punctuality	Be on time for classes.
Respect for Authority	Respect school staff and comply with the rules and policies of the school.
Respect for Others	Respect the right of fellow students to a school environment which is free from fears, prejudices and distractions. Understand that physical, sexual and verbal abuse of others is unacceptable. Resolve conflicts through discussion with the other person, or through assistance from school personnel. Respect the appropriate use of the email and the internet agreement that you signed.
Respect for Property	Respect the property of the school and of fellow students. Vandalism and graffiti are unacceptable.
Proper Dress	Students should dress in a manner appropriate to a school setting that is not distracting or disrespectful and follows the school's dress code. Personal hygiene should be practiced.
Substance abuse: tobacco, alcohol and drugs	Decline the use of illegal substances. Realize the severe consequences of bringing any of these substances to school.
Proper Language	Use of civil language is expected at all times. Crude, vulgar, obscene and blasphemous language should not be used. Racial and derogatory comments will not be tolerated.
Prepared for Class	Students should have all materials that are needed for class, complete homework and assignments on time, and prepare for assessments.
Responsible Use of Technology	Student will respect appropriate use of technology.

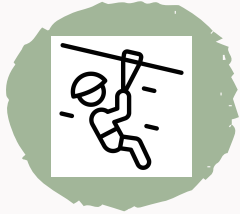

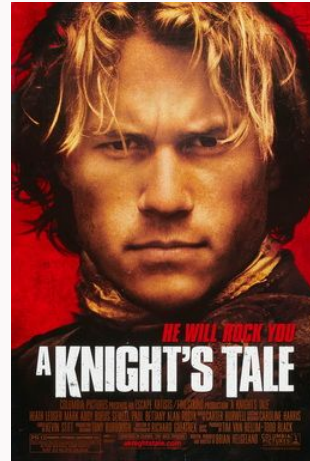
