Grade 8 Grad Party! Save the date!



STUDENT APPEARANCE/DRESS CODE

"Students are responsible for dressing appropriately for a school setting which is respectful and follows the dress code."

- 1. Shoulders, backs, chests and stomachs are to be covered (this applies to phys ed classes as well).
- 2. Spray perfumes, colognes and scented hand sanitizer are not permitted in the building due to severe allergies.
- 3. Hoods are not to be worn indoors. Hats are to be removed during O Canada, ceremonies and assemblies out of respect.
- 4. Offensive language/pictures on clothing is not permitted (swearing, references to drugs, alcohol or sexual comments).
- 5. Flip-flops and open-toed shoes are not permitted in the home ec or tech ed labs and gym for safety reasons.







Food Support
