Planning Priority #1

Students will increase their skills in reading fluency and comprehension and demonstrate progress in their writing abilities/capabilities.

Strategies and Success Indicators

- Teachers continued to collaborate using and reviewing literacy data to develop teaching approaches that will reflect best educational practices.
- Teachers collaborated to implement strategies to improve student literacy using the Reading Apprenticeship model
- Teachers collaborated with HSD Reading Clinicians and created partnerships to enhance teacher/student connections.

Planning Priority #2

Students will demonstrate critical and flexible thinking in their numeracy skills when applied in a variety of settings.

Strategies and Success Indicators

- Students developed vocabulary skills by focusing on using the correct vocabulary words while they are learning/practicing math concepts. Develop common grade level vocabulary expectations.
- Teachers used collaborate using and reviewing numeracy data to develop teaching approaches that will reflect best educational practices.
- Collaborated with divisional experts/learning coaches to assist newer teachers, teachers with larger class sizes, ideas for differentiation and classes with lower skills/math confidence.

Planning Priority #3
